Guidelines for conduct of KVS National Rashtriya Ekta Parv

A. Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat

1. Group Dance

Group Dance to be presented by the Region must be related with their Paired State allotted to the Region. Maximum time allowed for the dance will be 06 (six) minutes including the announcement. Number of participants allowed on the stage will be six to ten and minimum with four persons including the Music Teacher for background music and song. No person from outside KV will be allowed to play/sing. Pre-revised cassette or any other recorded device will not be allowed. The group dance will be performed in the costume of the State concerned.

Marks allotted for dance is detailed below:-

2. Group Song

Duration of the Group Song will be 4-5 minute including the announcement. The number of participants allowed on the stage will be 12 only. However, the number of students in the choir can be 6-10 and for background music, maximum 05 persons including the Music Teacher. The group song should be in the language of the State allotted to the Region. The theme of the song should be patriotism, national integration, Social cohesion, youth/women empowerment or the folklore of the State. The division of marks will be as under:-

(Supposing a school keeps 08 students in the singing choir, then they can have only four students for background music including music teacher. This way, schools can have the option to have number for singing choir and background music but the total on the stage should not be exceed 12).

The announcement of Song/Dance should not take more than 15 seconds.

3. Display of Artefacts/ Projects: -

The artefacts should represent rich culture arts and values of the allotted paired state stalls will be allotted for each region to display the artefacts. The area of stall will be intimated later by the Deputy Commissioner, KVS RO Kolkata. The stalls should be attractive, colourful and enrich with high standard artefacts depicting art and culture of allotted paired states, so that the message of Rashtriya Ekta Parv can be disseminated effectively.

4. On-the-Spot Painting:-

Theme will be given to the students for the On- the-spot Painting Competition. The theme will be disclosed on the same day of the competition. The maximum time to be allotted 90 Minutes.

ANNEXURE -VI

The Modalities for KVS Rashtriya Ekta Parv 2023

1. The details of paired states will be taken up by different regions for KVS Rashtriya Ekta Parv is enclosed as **Annexure -III**. The Social Science Teachers and students are to be encouraged to collect and prepare the best references/ articles/ materials etc. for the presentations to be displayed at the School/ Cluster/ Regional Level and National Level Competition. Every region will bring one project at the KVS Rashtriya Ekta parv. The activity is confined to allotted paired states and their rich culture.
2. To strengthen the idea of Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat an exhibition cum competition of artifacts will be organized at National Level. Regions will display the artefacts of paired states prepared by students in KVS Rashtriya Ekta Parv to showcase the rich heritage and art forms of the allotted paired state. Students will get all type of support from Kendriya Vidyalayas in preparing these artefacts. Each region will be provided with adequate space to display the artefacts at National Level Competition.
3. The school level exhibition should be conducted as inter class competition. The PGTs and TGTs of Humanities group and language teachers should be allotted duties through an office order. It is expected that school level competition should be conducted in a befitting manner. School Level Rashtriya Ekta Parv is to be held invariably in every Kendriya Vidyalaya.
4. The following competition will be conducted during KVS Regional and National Level Rashtriya Ekta Parv 2023.

A. Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat

1. Group Dance National
2. Group Song National
3. Display of Artefacts/Project
4. On the Spot Painting

B. KVS Kala Utsav

5. The Regional contingent shall comprise maximum **48 students**. The Regional contingent shall be escorted by a maximum 07 teachers (Two Music Teachers, Three Teachers with Humanities & Language background with adequate number of female teachers) including two accompanists. The details of Regional Team are given in **Annexure-IV**.
6. Each contingent will be led by Contingent Leader and supported by two Contingent Managers (01 Male & 1 Female Principal). The total Number of participants in KVS Rashtriya Ekta Parv 2023 will be 1200 students with 175 Escorts Teachers.
7. **The National Level KVS Rashtriya Ekta Parv is scheduled from 31st October to 02nd November 2023 at Kolkata.** The Deputy Commissioner, KVS Regional Office, Kolkata will make all necessary arrangements to organize the National Event in a befitting manner. The details of National Events will be intimated by the Deputy Commissioner KVS Regional Office Kolkata Shortly.
8. KVS Rashtriya Ekta Parv 2023 must be held at School, Cluster and Regional level. Selection of students, team and projects must be made judiciously. Parents, neighboring school, important local personalities are to be invited for the Exhibition being organized at School, Cluster and Regional level. This event at all levels must be conducted with enthusiasm and earnestness so that the aim and objective of the event is fully realized.
9. It is the responsibility of the organizers at each level to maintain utmost transparency in selecting the winners. The organizers have to ensure neutrality and the judges appointed should be from outside KV system for fair selection of teams at each level. The competition may be video graphed.
10. A pre- national Camp may be organized at Regional Level for Regional team for participation in KVS Rashtriya Ekta Parv. Eminent Artist/ Resource Persons from reputed art & Cultural organizations should be engaged to train students.
11. To promote National Integration, the Regional team which participated in National Level KVS Rashtriya Ekta Parv-2023 (**48 students**) will be taken for visit to the allotted States during Winter break or any other time as per convenience.
12. The students Exchange programme will be of 5 days and the team will be headed by a Principal and a team of escort teachers (with sufficient number of female teachers). The Regional Office will prepare the tour programme and inform it to the Deputy Commissioner of host Region well in advance to make necessary arrangements.
13. The host Region will arrange the stay in Kendriya Vidyalayas for visiting team. The Deputy Commissioner of host region will prepare plan of activities for visiting team that include excursions to 02 or 03 places of Cultural & Historical interest, workshops, meeting with eminent local artists, performance programmes of local art and culture, hand holding activities on dance, drama, songs, food, dress, handicrafts etc. where students of visiting team will learn and appreciate the culture of local state.
14. The expenditure incurred for students Exchange Programme will be borne out of Vidyalayas Vikas Nidhi of Vidyalaya concerned. If VVN of Vidyalaya is not sufficient it should be supplemented by Regional Offices from KVS Regional VVN Account.
15. The entries for the KVS National Level Kala Utsav Competition 2023 are to be sent in the form of videos and textual summary as outlined in the NCERT Kala Utsav Guidelines 2023. Textual summary of write up not more than 100 words, in MS word document format either in Hindi or English is to be submitted to this office as well as Host Region.

16. Each Regional Office will send selected name of 02 students (1 male +1 female) under each category (Total 20 students) for participation in the KVS National Level Kala Utsav Competition 2023 to host Region i.e **KVS RO Kolkata**.
17. Further, it is also requested to Host Regions i.e KVS RO Kolkata to send the details of 02 selected students (01 Boy & 01 Girl) under each 10 category (**Total 20 students**) in given excel sheet as **Annexure I** to this office by **05th November 2023** on email ID akamkvshq@gmail.com . Needless to mention that, while sending data, write up and information to this office, there need to through checking at your end.
18. The winners of KVS National Kala Utsav will participate in offline Mode in National Kala Utsav organized by NCERT in the month of January 2024.
